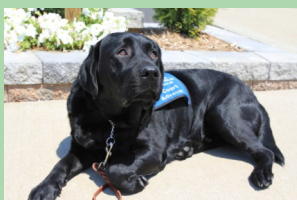

2012 Year End Report

Friends,

During 2012, Kids' Harbor was faced with both challenges and many opportunities. We are blessed to live in a caring, generous, and committed community. It is because of the generosity of this community, a dedicated board and caring staff, which ensured every child who came forward last year, had a safe place to tell their story. With your continued support, we can make sure we help even more children during 2013 and beyond.

I would like to thank the donors, volunteers, board and staff who make this organization possible. It is through your assistance we continue to be able to provide all of our services to children and their non-offending caregivers at no cost.

Headlines during the past few months have confronted us with a startling disregard for the welfare of children from the British Broadcasting Company (BBC) to the Boy Scouts, institutions who chose to put their own interests above the safety of children. Statistics continue to tell us 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys will be sexually abused before their 18th birthday and only 1 in 10 of those children will report their abuse.

During 2012, the Task Force on the Prevention of Sexual Abuse of Children researched what improvements needed to be made to prevent children in Missouri from falling through the cracks. This report, released in early 2013, provided 22 recommendations to the Governor, General Assembly and State Board of Education on changes which need to be made to ensure the safety of Missouri's Children. Among these recommendations, comprehensive community based education programs to educate both adults and children in safety. Several years ago, Kids' Harbor had a prevention program in area schools however because of budget cuts and the decline of the economy; this is a program the agency lost. My goal for 2013, is to re-establish a prevention program for both children and adults in our community.

In 2012, 614 children were referred to Kids' Harbor for services. While the number is down from the 643 children seen in 2011, our referrals were up at the Osage Beach office while we saw fewer children at the St. Robert office. The vast majority of the children seen were referred for allegations of sexual abuse (74%) and over 99% of the children seen knew their alleged perpetrator. Our counseling program continues to be at capacity and at times, requires us to refer families outside agencies for therapy. During 2013, Kids' Harbor will be seeking additional funding to hire an additional therapist to meet the needs of the families we serve.

Looking forward to 2013, we have begun a much needed expansion and renovation at our St. Robert, Missouri location. This expansion will allow us to provide more comprehensive services to families in the area. In addition, this expansion will allow us to protect the confidentiality of those families served. Look for an announcement for our open house once the renovations are completed!

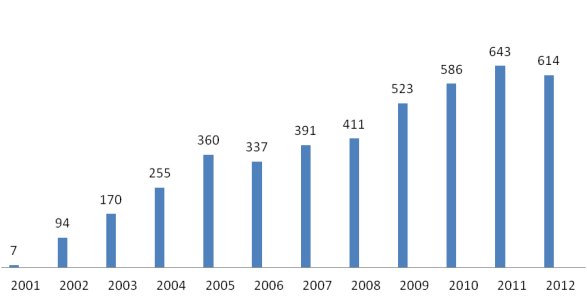

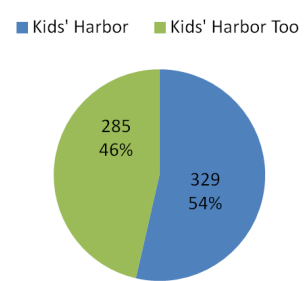

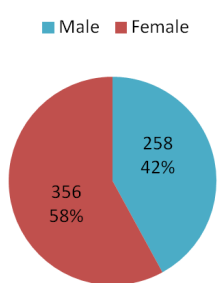
Rate of Growth 2001-2012



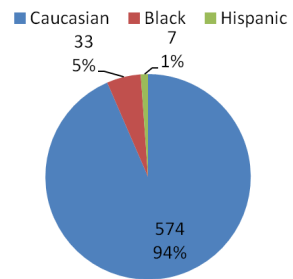
Referrals by Location-2012



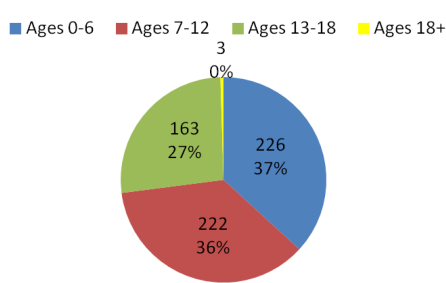
Gender of Total Clients 2012-614



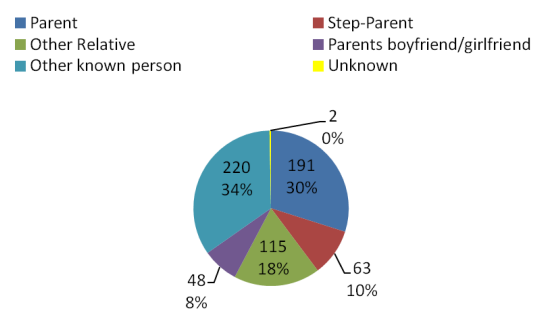
Clients by Ethnicity- 2012



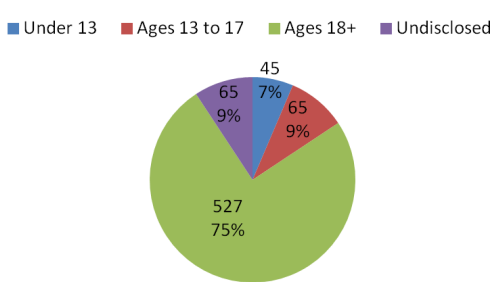
Ages of Clients-2012



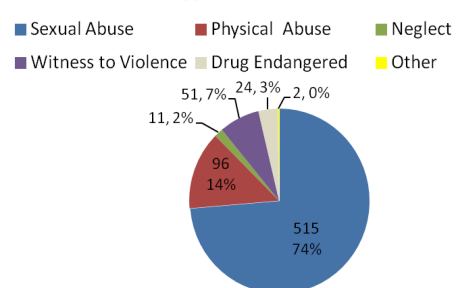
Alleged Offenders-2012



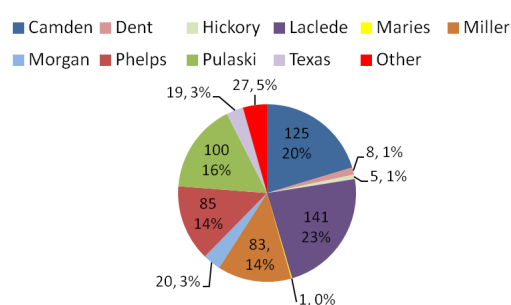
Ages of Alleged Offenders-2012
